Norms set for discharge of functions:

- 1. Patient examination, investigation and treatment in OPD, indoor as per HomeopathicPrincipals .
- 2. Purchase Section: As per the Rules laid down in GFR
- 3. Planning Section: As per the requirements.
- 4. Accounts branch: As per the Rules laid down in GFR
- 5. Clinical meetings: Clinical meetings / Seminars/ Conferences/ Training Sessions are organized at regular intervals and rare and interesting cases are discussed among facultymembers including house physicians and Senior resident doctors.

Time frame: - Requisite information is provided within maximum of 30 days.
