**Brief history and background**

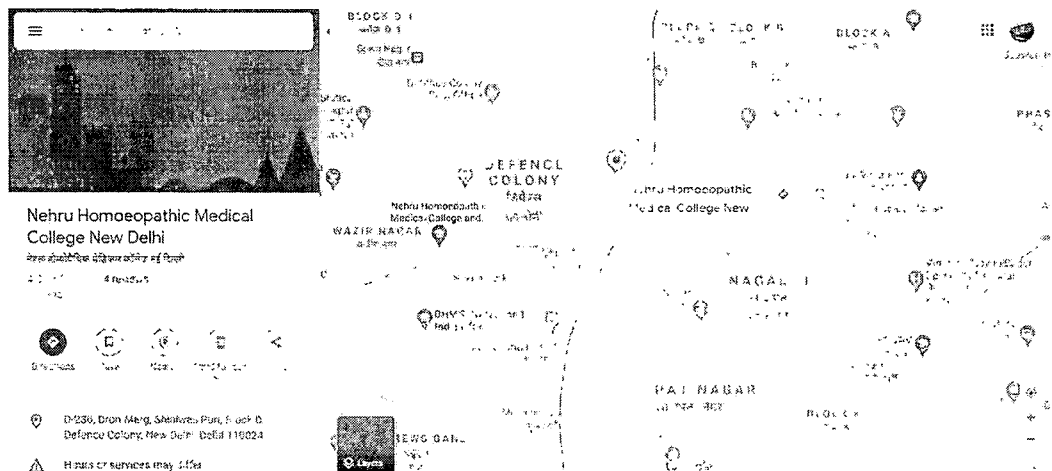
Nehru Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital was founded by Padam Bhushan Awardee Late Dr.Yudhvir Singh, a great freedom fighter, social worker and pioneer Homoeopath of India. The institution was founded by Padma Bhushan Awardee Late Dr.Yudhvir Singh, a great freedom fighter, social worker and pioneer Homoeopath of India. The foundation stone of the college building was laid by Hon'ble Dr.Sushila Nayyar, Minister of Health and Family Welfare at that time on 22nd August 1963. The OPD Wing was inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Prime Minister, Late Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri on 6th May 1964. Classes in the college were started from 1967 for DHMS Course, upgraded to BHMS course under the Board of Homoeopathic System of Medicine. On 01st September 1972 this institution was handed over by Dr.Yudhvir Singh Charitable Trust to Delhi Administration. The college is affiliated to University of Delhi for award of BHMS Degree since 1992.

**Head of the Organization:** Principal/MS

**Mission/Vision:** This institute has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing and promoting homoeopathic education and training to collate, and setting up the standards in the fields of research and community health care. Significant progress has been achieved since the inception of the institution in Directorate of ISM&H (Ayush), Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi.

**Aims and Objectives of the organization:**

- i) To encourage and provide qualitative education to the students and establishment of infrastructure required for medical care facilities.
- ii) To promote medical care facilities to the extent feasible to take measures to encourage citizen to choose a system of medicine for treatment of ailments under Homoeopathy within the NCT of Delhi.
- iii) To facilitate research and development activities in homoeopathy.

**Departments of the organization:**

The institution has various teaching departments-Materia Medica, Organon and Homoeopathic Philosophy, Repertory, Pharmacy, Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry and Pathology, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Community Medicine, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics, Medicine, and a Library. The departments are equipped with modern instruments and equipment's as per the regulations laid down by the CCH/NCH. The different departments of the institution are being strengthened in phased manner by adding various teaching aids and materials such as instruments, equipment's, specimens, models, slides, video cassettes, CDs, posters, charts, etc. The Seminar room is equipped with LCD Projectors, OHP and Slide Projector for audio visual Presentations. The institute is also actively engaged in research activities.

The college imparts 5½ year of course in Bachelor of Homoeopathic System of Medicine and Surgery. The admission capacity is 125 students per year. The college also imparts 3 year Post Graduate Course M.D.(Hom) in three specialties viz Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine & Practice of Medicine.

**Indoor Patient department:**

The Hospital has a capacity of 100 beds with separate male and female wards. Interns, Junior Residents, Senior Residents and IPD In-charge look after the IPD 24 hours a day. Qualified nursing and paramedical staff is also posted in the IPD. Regular breakfast, lunch, evening tea and dinner and along with medicines and investigations are provided free of cost to all patients.
